Admission Requirements

(must have at least one of the following)

- Grade 12 diploma from a Canadian high school or an equivalent level institution worldwide
- Successful completion of the Government Equivalency Diploma (GED)
- Apply as a mature student (over 19) and successfully complete the Canadian Tourism College Entrance Exam with a minimum 65%
- Have completed a tourism or hospitality related program at CTC, or another college (pending review)

English Requirements

(must have at least one of the following)

- IELTS score of at least 5.5 or equivalent.
- TOEFL score CBT: 163, IBT: 57 or equivalent.
- CTC English assessment (written on site) with a score of 65%
- CTC online English assessment with a score of 70%
- Level 5 training at an ESL school.
